Most Reverend Sam G. Jacobs was installed as Bishop of Houma-Thibodaux in 2003 after serving 14 years as bishop for the Diocese of Alexandria. Bishop Jacobs was born in Greenwood, MS, and raised in Lake Charles, LA. He holds undergraduate and graduate degrees in Philosophy and a graduate degree in Education/Administration from The Catholic University of America. He has served on numerous committees for the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops. For years, he has been a national speaker focusing on the power of the Holy Spirit.

Maria Vadia was baptized in the Holy Spirit in 1987 and consecrated her life to the Lord Jesus Christ and to preaching the Gospel. Maria is founder of the “Jesus is Lord” chapter of Magnificat in Miami, and a member of the Advisory Board of Magnificat, International, a ministry for Catholic Women. She has traveled around America, Cuba, Trinidad & Tobago, Barbados, Jamaica, Mexico, Malta, Ghana, Nicaragua, Uganda, Indonesia, Canada and India bringing a message of faith, salvation and healing. She ministers the Word to various prayer groups, including “The King Jesus Prayer Group” which she has faithfully led since 1992, as well as at the Miami Women’s Detention Center and Genesis House, a home for the homeless with AIDS (presently closed). She has authored three books and is the mother of four.

Sister Ann Shields, SGL, is a noted speaker and author whose activities as an internationally known evangelist have taken her to Eastern Europe, Africa, Australia, New Zealand, the Caribbean, Central America, Israel, the Philippines, and the British Isles, as well as numerous cities in the United States and Canada. Based in Ann Arbor, she is the Superior of the Servants of God’s Love, a charismatic religious community canonically established in the Diocese of Lansing, Michigan. Sr. Ann served in higher education for eighteen years as an English instructor and as head of college campus ministry. She is currently the host of a daily radio program, a frequent speaker at national and international conferences, and an author.

Kelly Pease is a Louisiana native who now lives in sunny Steubenville, OH. A gifted musician, Kelly has been writing and recording music for the past ten years. Her latest album, Kelly Pease, was released in September 2007. Kelly travels the country leading worship and sharing the story of God’s faithfulness in her life. She works closely with an inner-city ministry for teens, Dirty Vagabond. Kelly is married to the love of her life and she and her husband, Joey, are expecting their first child in this Spring. Kelly is blessed to be a part of what God is doing in his young people and in his church!

Josh Blaksley’s Christian music journey began in 1992 when he vowed to be “sold out” for Christ and to use his gift of writing music to glorify God. Josh has led praise and worship at World Youth Day in Denver, Colorado, Steubenville Youth Conferences and at Catholic Heart Work Camps and Life Teen Camps. He has contributed songs to several compilation albums and released his first solo album, *Immersed* in 2003. Josh currently serves as young adult coordinator and assistant music director at Our Lady of Prompt Succor Catholic Church in Alexandria, Louisiana. He travels many weekends to other parishes throughout the U.S. doing concerts, conducting workshops for musicians, speaking at youth rallies and conferences, and leading praise and worship.
